4. **Presentation on the Geary Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) and Improvement Project.** More than 54,000 people a day rely on 38 Geary local, rapid and express bus service to get where they need to go, but uneven wait times, overcrowded buses and inconsistent travel times are a daily reality. These issues persist even with recent improvements like more rush hour service and red bus-only lanes. The Geary Boulevard project, led by the San Francisco County Transportation Authority and San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency, will address these issues, making transit almost as quick and convenient and more vibrant Geary corridor. **(Discussion Item)**
