Dear Ms. Calvillo.

On June 14, 2021, the Small Business Commission (SBC) heard BOS File No. 210598: Administrative Code - Reimbursement for Broken Windows Due to Vandalism, presented by Tom Temprano, aide to Supervisor Mandelman. The SBC supports the Board of Supervisors establishing this special fund that is to expired two years after the date of enactment.

The establishment of this fund recognizes that the recovery of the pandemic is a multi-year process and small businesses continued to be at risk to break-ins and random acts vandalism. During the last 14 months of this pandemic, countless small businesses experienced damaged windows, often multiple times. Many reported that their insurance did not cover multiple window replacements and it put them at risk for an increased insurance premiums.

The SBC did highlight in its discussions the need of the City to focus on prevention and eliminating the social conditions that contribute to the need for establishing this fund.
